To whom it may concern,

I am writing to you with worry and strong objection to the above proposal.

My family have lived in the village for over 30 years and we are so upset by the constant proposals for the planning of a 24hr logistics centre in this absolutely inappropriate location.

Start Hill has become so dangerous in recent years. We have lived in this village for a long time and we love the location. The village atmosphere has changed over the last 10 years. I have 2 young children who use the roads on their bikes. I have 2 horses who regularly are ridden through the village. I am a runner also and am forced to run on the roads as there is not enough pavement.

The village has already become dangerous for pedestrians, children, animals with the increasing vehicles coming through the village by the way of diversions for roadworks. These people drive at ridiculous speeds through the village and i am now forced to seek alternative routes in order to protect myself and family on our own doorstep. Sometimes we have no choice but to risk it.

I understand that there have been amendments to the proposals but the increase in traffic during diversions, the pollution, the increased noise pollution, the damage to wildlife will be immense. The road through Great Hallingbury is already damaged and has so many pot holes some marked with cones, some are simple holes in the ground, drains with no covers. They are so dangerous.

We have this year had Kites return to the area to breed and mistletoe growing in the trees. This area is so precious. The damage would be permanent and irreversible.

This is a residential area. This is not an industrial area that can support such a proposal. The light pollution would also be so damaging.

Please refuse planning for this logistics centre. I am not opposed to construction but this site is just not and never will be appropriate.
