Charge creation dates	No 'charge-creation-dates' are present on the HM Land Registry register for records forming part of the migrated dataset (i.e. prior to the initial data load at the point of serving notice on 28/03/2023). This is due to creation-dates not being reliably available from the source register database. From the point of serving notice and Epping Forest District Council's API interacting with HM Land Registry,	Records created prior to 28/03/2023 will not provide a charge-creation-date. Creation date Not provided Records created (or varied) on or after 28/03/2023 will display a charge-creation-date. Creation date 16 April 2023

Charges on abutting roadways	Prior to migration to the HM Land Registry register, a search of land or property abutting a road affected by a charge would reveal the charge for the roadway. This will not be the case on the HM Land Registry service, and the spatial search will need to cover the roadway in order to guarantee obtaining any charge information affecting that roadway.	Before: Charges for roadways / highways / streets will have been revealed on a search of the abutting land / property. After: The spatial search of land / property will need to include a part of the roadway / highway / street in order to see the registrations affecting it.

Search results may feature registrations against properties linked to the address searched that were linked only by the UPRN.

The HM Land Registry results will only feature registrations covered by the spatial extent used to search.

Before: A search of 100 High Street that had a linked UPRN to a Garage nearby would reveal local land charges against both 100 High Street and the Garage.

After: Only local land charges against 100 High Street would be revealed if the spatial search extent did not incorporate the garage.
