Charge Creation and Charge Registration Dates	The creation date for some charges has been found to be inconsistent with the registration date. Charges excluded from the Register	<p>A policy review has resulted in the cancellation from the Register of the following charges:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Conditional planning charges predating 01/08/1977 • National Park planning records submitted to Scarborough Borough Council for consultation. 	
Conditional planning consents (Appeals)	A review has resulted in a small number of conditional planning charges being added to the Register. These all relate to planning appeals.	



Sites with Communal Areas	Search results for a specific property which is part of a site with communal areas will no longer display charges, including Tree Preservation Orders, relating to the whole communal site. This was a manual consideration made by Scarborough Borough Council and will not automatically be part of the HMLR service.	
New Build Estates	Search results for specific properties which are part of a recent new build housing development may not include some charges which cover other areas of the whole development site. Scarborough Borough Council manually review these sites and include neighbouring charges for information. E.g. Charges relating to access roads. This will not be part of the HMLR search.
