IV. Disease freedom assurances

- i) lentivirus (maedi-visna / caprine arthritis encephalitis) and rift valley fever during the three (3) years prior to export;
- ii) enzootic abortion of ewes and sheep pulmonary adenomatosis during the two (2) years prior to export;
- iii) Q fever during the twelve (12) months prior to export;
- iv) brucellosis (B. abortus and B. melitensis), sheep epididymitis (B. ovis) contagious agalactia, tuberculosis, paratuberculosis and bluetongue during the six (6) months prior to export;
- v) vesicular stomatitis during the six (6) months prior to export and within a radius of fifteen (15) km;
- vi) akabane virus, border disease and Q fever in the twelve (12) months prior to export.
