JUDGMENT

- 1. The Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant compensation for injury to feeling on the complaint of a failure to make reasonable adjustments in the sum of £14,000.00
- 2. That award also caries interest at the rate of 8 per cent per annum (£1,120.00) for the period from 3rd November 2020 to date, 2 years and 167 days, in the further sum of £2,752.44
- 3. The Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant a compensatory award for unfair dismissal in the sum of £5,194.19, calculated at follows:

26 weeks loss of net earnings @ £305.18 per week	£7934.68
Less Employment Support Allowance (ESA) received	- <u>£2002.00</u>
	£5932.68
Loss of statutory rights	£500.00
Loss of employer's pension contribution @£82.15 per mon	th <u>£492.90</u>
	£6925.58
Less 25 percent Polkey_reduction	<u>-£1731.39</u>
	£5194.19

- 4. The Tribunal is satisfied that because the ESA is not income-related the requirements of paragraph 4 of the Employment Protection (Recoupment of Benefits) Regulations 1996 do not apply.
- 5. The total amount of compensation awarded is therefore £21,964.63
