I am writing to oppose the proposed development on the basis that significant damage to the wildlife has already been done and further development would fully destroy the natural habitats that remain. It would harm the openness of the greenbelt and shouldn't be considered because work was started prior to any biodiversity study. This means the pre-existing natural environment has not been recorded and as such the site should be allowed to fully re-nature prior to any further consideration.

Please send a message that it is not appropriate to start any form of work and destroy wildlife in advance of seeking appropriate approvals.
