With reference to the above application for planning approval I once again strongly object to this proposal.

I am an Uttlesford resident of Great Hallingbury who uses the B1256 on a daily basis to access nearby towns, infrastructure, schools and carry out activities of daily living.

I live very close to the proposed site, the road is already very congested during certain periods during the day. I have children, who walk up this road and this would pose an even higher risk than there already is considering there is no footpath. My children are late to school most mornings as the traffic on this road in the mornings are very unpredictable, sometimes with tailbacks that last for quite some duration and this would just exacerbate the situation. I also believe it would have a negative impact on the environment. This is residential area and quite honestly I am surprised that such a proposal would even be considered.

I must say, I fail to understand after two already rejected applications, why are they being allowed to submit yet another application, there should be rules in place to stop this. No should mean no.
