Once again, for a third time, we find ourselves confronted with a further application from Wren Kitchens.

This proposal has been successfully refused on each of the previous applications, is it not therefore possible to confirm that under no circumstance would the building of a 24hr Distribution/Logistics Centre be acceptable!?

It would appear that the plans are now to be considered by the Home Secretary and I hope there remains steadfast agreement with the view of previous Uttlesford Council decisions.

It is very clear that such an open logistics facility in a village setting would have adverse effects on local environment. There would be increased traffic chaos at an already busy junction leading to the M11 at J8. Increased traffic in the village would increase the danger to local residents where there are already no pavements. The noise pollution from such a facility would also create an intolerable environment for those living close by, effecting mental health and physical health. The area on which the proposed facility would stand is also protected as part of the Stansted Airport development plans and green belt development.
