



As a condition of authorisation mortalities must be recorded as and when they occur. If no mortalities are occurring, you must record 0 weekly at a minimum. Mortalities can be recorded in a preferred format, but it must include the number of mortalities, species affected and zone (if your farm is divided into zones). These records must be maintained and available for inspection as required. It may be prudent to also record the possible cause of mortalities. All unexplained or abnormal mortalities or suspicion of listed disease must be reported to the Fish Health Inspectorate. Acceptable formats include daily diaries, spreadsheets, biosecurity logbooks. An example of an acceptable mortality log is shown below.
