## JUDGMENT

1. The claimant's claim for unlawful deduction from wages is not well-founded and fails.
2. The claimant's claim for unpaid accrued holiday pay upon termination of employment is not well-founded and fails.
3. The claimant's claim for unpaid notice is not well-founded and fails.
4. The claimant's claim for compensation for mental health, loss of income and severe stress is not within the Tribunal's jurisdiction and fails.
5. The claimant's claim for an itemised pay statement is not well-founded and fails.
