JUDGMENT

- The Tribunal has jurisdiction to hear the claim for unfair dismissal under section 111(2)(b) of the Employment Rights Act 1996. It was not reasonably practicable for the claimant to present the claim within the time period allowed by section 111(2)(a) (as extended by section 207B) of that Act and he presented it within a further period that the Tribunal considers reasonable.
- 2. The Tribunal has jurisdiction to hear the claims for direct age discrimination and direct sex discrimination under section 123(1)(b) of the Equality Act 2010. The claims were not presented within the time period allowed by section 123(1)(a) (as extended by section 140B) of that Act but were presented within a period the Tribunal thinks just and equitable.
