## JUDGMENT

The Judgment of the Employment Tribunal is that:-

- 1. The respondent made an unauthorised deduction from the claimant's wages by failing to pay to her remuneration for her week worked in hand.
- 2. The respondent shall pay to the claimant the sum of £311.45 which is one weeks' gross average wages and is the amount of the unauthorised deduction.
- 3. The respondent has failed to pay to the claimant the sums due to her by way of compensation for holiday accrued but untaken during the holiday year commencing 1 April 2023.
- 4. The claimant accrued 15 days holiday entitlement as at 18 October 2022 (being the date of termination of the contract). At an average gross daily rate of £62.29, the claimant is entitled to compensation in the sum of £934.35.
- 5. The parties agreed that the claimant may carry forward two days of accrued holiday untaken during holiday year ended 31 March 2021. This amount remains unpaid and was therefore outstanding upon termination of the contract of employment. The respondent shall pay to the claimant the sum of £124.58 being two days gross wages by way of compensation for breach of contract.

6. The total sum payable by the respondent to the claimant is in the sum of £1370.38 gross. This sum shall be paid to her on or before **5 May 2023**.
