## JUDGMENT

- 1. By concession, the claim of unlawful deduction of wages is well founded and succeeds.
- 2. The Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant the gross sum of £4,713.52.
- 3. The following complaints are not well-founded and are dismissed:
  - a. Direct disability discrimination (section 13 Equality Act 2010),
  - b. Discrimination because of something arising in consequence of disability (section 15 Equality Act 2010),
  - c. Failure to make reasonable adjustments (sections 20-21 Equality Act 2010),
  - d. Victimisation (section 27 Equality Act 2010),
  - e. Unfair dismissal (section 103A and section 98 Employment Rights Act 1996)
