This concerns my strongest objection, as a neighbour, to the application for a 24/7 logistics centre on land at Tilekiln Green, Great Hallingbury.

The road running through Great Hallingbury is already too congested with cars avoiding Bishops Stortford and frequent diverting traffic from the M11. The road is in very poor condition and any extra traffic would be intolerable and also raise safety issues. Especially near the Esso turn off and in terms of pedestrians from the new housing development and the longer established hotel.

The village is under the Stansted flight path and suffers more then surrounding areas with consequent noise pollution. The proposed development would only exacerbate this situation.

Approval of the application would result in enormous short term disruption and in the longer term degrade the village to an adjunct of an industrial area. The proposal is entirely out of keeping with the historic village site and prove harmful from a noise, safety, traffic and aesthetic perspective.
