

**DETERMINATION BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR BUSINESS, ENERGY  
AND INDUSTRIAL STRATEGY**

**OF THE EU EMISSIONS TRADING SYSTEM (EU ETS) CARBON PRICE UNDER  
THE GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS TRADING SCHEME REGULATIONS 2012**

1. This is a determination by the Secretary of State for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy (“the Secretary of State”) of the value of the carbon price for the scheme year beginning on 1 January 2020 (“the 2020 carbon price”) under regulation 49 of the Greenhouse Gas Emissions Trading Scheme Regulations 2012 (“the 2012 Regulations”).
2. The 2020 carbon price is calculated in accordance with the following criteria as set out in regulation 49(2) of the 2012 Regulations:
  - a. Futures Price: the average December 2020 EU Allowance (EUA) futures price traded between 12 November 2018 and 11 November 2019;
  - b. Exchange Rate: the average Euro-Sterling exchange rate of the Bank of England between 12 November 2018 and 11 November 2019.
3. **The Secretary of State therefore determines that**
  - **the carbon price for the scheme year beginning on 1 January 2020 is £21.93**

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<sup>1</sup> The average futures price and the average exchange rate are rounded to the second place after the decimal point; conversion from Euros to Pounds was performed on unrounded numbers.
