I should like to object to the above application

smiths Green is at the heart of the village of Takeley - with beautiful grassy open spaces leading to Priory Wood and the fields

Every day there are dozens of walkers and cyclists - with and without dogs - using the lanes and walking down Jacks Lane

jacks Lane is a single track road with houses along one side and beautiful woods - which are the habitat of the local deer and foxes - along the other

It is the most idyllic countryside redolent of everything that Essex stands for.

Another 40 houses are totally unnecessary and will impact most greatly on traffic

The B1256 which was downgraded from the A120 is already at capacity - as is the doctors surgery and the pharmacy. The dentist too now has no capacity -

Weston Homes are intent on ruining the village of Takeley - they are already cramming more houses into what was their car park and are intent on covering all the Takeley fields with houses
