JUDGMENT

1. The parties having reached an agreement, the claim of unlawful deduction of wages in respect of unpaid wages is dismissed upon withdrawal.
2. The claim under regulation 30 Working Time Regulations 1998 in respect of outstanding accrued holiday pay upon termination of employment is well founded and succeeds.
3. The Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant the gross sum of **£356.25** (being in respect of 5 days outstanding leave at the rate of £71.25 a day).
