	JUDGMENT

- 1. The parties having reached an agreement, the claim of unlawful deduction of wages in respect of unpaid wages is dismissed upon withdrawal.
- 2. The claim under regulation 30 Working Time Regulations 1998 in respect of outstanding accrued holiday pay upon termination of employment is well founded and succeeds.
- 3. The Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant the gross sum of £356.25 (being in respect of 5 days outstanding leave at the rate of £71.25 a day).
