Permissions

- 4.3. customer credit arrangements/any arrangements by customers to make prepayments to Gazprom Germania and/or any of its Subsidiaries;
- 4.4. provision of clearing services to Gazprom Germania and/or any of its Subsidiaries;
- 4.5. payments and loan arrangements between Gazprom Germania and/or any of its Subsidiaries;
- 4.6. issuing and providing financing for letters of credit.
- 5. A Relevant UK Institution may process payments made in accordance with paragraph 4.

Record-keeping Requirements

6. A Person purporting to rely on this Licence must keep accurate, complete and readable records, on paper or electronically, of any activity purporting to have been permitted under this licence for a minimum of 6 years.

General

- 7. The permissions in this licence do not authorise any act which the person carrying out the act knows, or has reasonable grounds for suspecting, will result in funds or economic resources being dealt with or made available in breach of the Russia Regulations save as permitted under this or other licences granted under the Russia Regulations.
- 8. Information provided to HM Treasury in connection with this licence shall be disclosed to third parties only in compliance with the UK General Data Protection Regulation and the Data Protection Act 2018.
- 9. This licence takes effect from 23:59 on 28 October 2022 and expires on 23:59 on 29 October 2023
- 10. HM Treasury may vary, revoke or suspend this licence at any time.
