## **JUDGMENT**

- 1. The Tribunal declares that the Claimant's complaint that the Respondent made unauthorised deductions from his wages is well-founded.
- 2. The Tribunal ORDERS the Respondent to pay the sum of £12,045.15 to the Claimant in respect of the unauthorised deductions aforesaid.
- 3. The Tribunal additionally orders the Respondent to pay the sum of £1,655.03 to the Claimant to compensate him for the higher rate income tax that it determines will be payable on the sum ordered to be paid under paragraph 2 above.
- 4. The Claimant's various complaints under the Equality Act 2010 of direct and indirect discrimination, harassment and victimisation, with reference to
