JUDGMENT

1. The Tribunal finds that the claim for unlawful deduction of wages is well-founded and awards the Claimant as follows:
 - i. £20.84 (gross) on account of an unlawful deduction from wages on 19 July 2021;
 - ii. £134.89 (gross) on account of an unlawful deduction from wages between 21 - 29 July 2021 inclusive.

These sums are only to be paid by the Respondent to the extent that they have not already been paid.

2. The Tribunal finds that the claim for breach of contract is not well-founded.
3. The Tribunal finds that the claim of unfair dismissal is not well-founded.
