# JUDGMENT

The unanimous Judgment of the Tribunal is set out below.

1. This judgment applies to all claimants listed in the attached schedule.

2. On the 5 December 2019, the first respondent dismissed the claimants by reason of redundancy. The dismissals were with immediate effect.

3. The first respondent failed to inform and consult with the claimants and so breached its obligations under s188 and s188A of the Trade Union and Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992 (the 1992 Act).

4. The claimants have raised a complaint pursuant to s189 of the 1992 Act seeking a protective award in respect of that failure.

5. The Tribunal makes an award under s189 of the 1992 Act in favour of the claimants named in the attached schedule for the maximum protected period of 90 days commencing on 5 December 2019.

6. This schedule includes 3 claimants Sarah Wilson, Tomas Quinn and Romeo Maku-Kemi. Whilst those claimants were paid by invoice for the latter period of their employment (from May 2019) the Tribunal is satisfied that these

claimants worked for the first respondent under a contract of employment until the date of their dismissal on 5 December 2019.

7. The respondent is ordered to pay remuneration to the claimants for the protected period.

8. The recoupment provisions apply to this award.
