



Introduction




From 20 June 2023, 6 million people in the UK who get certain disability benefits will automatically get a one-off £150 payment.

We call this a Disability Cost of Living Payment.



This payment is to help with the rising cost of living and higher disabilityrelated costs, such as care and mobility needs.

People on low income benefits



For disabled people on a low income, the payment of **£150** comes **on top** of other Cost of Living payments, such as:

- £301 was automatically paid in May
- £300 will be paid in the Autumn.



To get the Disability Cost of Living Payment, a person must have received one of the following qualifying benefits:

- Attendance Allowance
- Constant Attendance Allowance





- Adult Disability Payment (in Scotland)
- Child Disability Payment (in Scotland)



- Armed Forces Independence Payment
- War Pension Mobility Supplement.

The disability payment will start on **20 June 2023** and may take a few weeks before you see it in your account.

Most payments will be made by 4 July 2023.



Those who qualify for the disability payment will get their £150 in the same way they get their regular benefit payments.



The Disability Cost of Living Payment is assessed on an individual basis.



If a household has multiple disabled occupants, each eligible person will get a Disability Cost of Living Payment.



Other payments for all households



There are specific types of payment depending on your circumstances, such as:

- People on low-income benefits
- Pensioners
- People on disability benefits.
