The bolts marked as 4.8 are not of adequate strength.</li> <li>Bolts marked as grade 8.8 may be of insufficient strength to meet the standard for grade 8.8 bolts.</li> <li>The safety and strength of the arm restraint mechanism relies on the 8.8 bolts being tightened to the correct torque.
