JUDGMENT

The complaint of detriment on the grounds of being, not being or proposing to become a trade union member is struck out.

REASONS

1. By a letter dated 15 May 2023 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to make representations or to request a hearing, as to why the complaint of *detriment on the grounds of being, not being or proposing to become a trade union member* should not be struck out because:
 - The claimant had not complied with the Order of the Tribunal dated 13 January 2023
 - It has not been actively pursued.
2. The claimant has failed to make representations in writing, or has failed to make any sufficient representations, why this should not be done or to request a hearing. The complaint of *detriment on the grounds of being, not being or proposing to become a trade union member* is therefore struck out.
3. The claimant's remaining claim(s) remains listed for hearing on 27 November 2023.
