Thank you for your email of 20 February 2023 in which you requested the following information:

- 1. The total public funds committed to Adventurous Training Courses and expeditions and number of participants for the training years 2022/23 (to date).
- 2. For the three most expensive trips in 2022/23 (to date), please state the activity, the duration, the number of people that attended and IF POSSIBLE the spend on hotel, spend on travel etc.
- 3. Please provide a breakdown of spending by activity. For example, £200,000 Nordic skiing in Norway, £300,000 scuba diving in Indonesia, £150,000 sailing in Corfu etc.).

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) 2000. A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence, and I can confirm that the information in scope of your request is held and is provided at Annex A.

For part 1 of the request, total public spend for Adventure Training courses could not be provided. The data is held but has not been compiled and is therefore not held by the Department. This is because the raw data does exist but would need to be analysed to produce a new information set. As we do not hold this information set, we are not required to provide it under the framework of the Act.

Under section 16 (Advice and Assistance) of the Freedom of Information act, please be advised that Adventurous Training is designed to take individuals outside their comfort zone. The Adventurous Training Leadership and Resilience programme (ALeRT) develops leadership, resilience, coping strategies, decision making, teamwork, physical fitness and courage. With this comes a sense of achievement and camaraderie through tackling challenges together. A renewed sense of self determination makes for better soldiers and enables better lifestyle decisions.
