## JUDGMENT

The judgment of the Tribunal is that:

- 1. The claimant resigned from her employment with the respondent by letter dated 10 September 2021, with effect on 8 October 2021; she was not dismissed.
- 2. Furthermore, at the material time, there were no circumstances of danger which the claimant reasonably believed were serious and imminent which she could not reasonably have been expected to avert.
- The claimant's claim that she was constructively unfairly dismissed under s.95 Employment Rights Act 1996 (ERA), by reason of hers being a "Health and Safety case" as provided for at s.100 (1) (d) and/or (e) ERA, fails and is dismissed.
