## JUDGMENT

- 1. Following the judgment on liability sent to the parties on 24 February 2023, the claimant is awarded the following sums:
- 2. For harassment and victimisation:
  - a. Injury to feelings £15000
  - b. ACAS uplift of 10% on injury to feelings £1500
  - c. Interest on injury to feelings from 15 January 2020 to 12 May 2023 £4390.36
  - d. Financial losses £3597.23
  - e. ACAS uplift of 10% on financial losses £359.72
  - f. Interest on those financial losses from the midpoint between 12 July 2021 and 12 May 2023 £290.54.
- For unlawful deduction of wages (as set out in our judgment on liability): £1177 (gross – any issues around tax deductions will need to be taken up with HMRC).
- 4. The total of all the above figures at paragraphs 2 and 3 is £26,314.85.
