## JUDGMENT

The Judgment of the Tribunal is that:

1. The Respondent did not unfairly dismiss the Claimant.
2. The Respondent did not wrongfully dismiss the Claimant, so the Claimant is not entitled to notice pay.
3. The Respondent did not fail to pay the Claimant for his accrued holiday on termination of his employment.
4. The Respondent made unlawful deductions of £100 gross from the Claimant's pay.
5. The Respondent shall pay the Claimant £100 gross for unlawful deductions from wages.
