## **JUDGMENT**

## The Judgment of the Tribunal is that:

1. The Respondent did not unfairly dismiss the Claimant.

- 2. The Respondent did not wrongfully dismiss the Claimant, so the Claimant is not entitled to notice pay.
- 3. The Respondent did not fail to pay the Claimant for his accrued holiday on termination of his employment.
- 4. The Respondent made unlawful deductions of £100 gross from the Claimant's pay.
- 5. The Respondent shall pay the Claimant £100 gross for unlawful deductions from wages.
