## JUDGMENT

The Employment Judge gave Judgment as follows:

- 1. The Claimant's employment did not transfer to the 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent. The claims against the 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent fail and are dismissed.
- 2. The claim for a protective award fails and is dismissed.
- 3. The Claimant was dismissed by the 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent by reason of redundancy and is entitled to a redundancy payment of £5,341.96.

- 4. The Claimant was dismissed by the 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent in breach of contract in respect of notice and the 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent is ordered to pay compensation to the Claimant in the sum of £2,528.68.
- 5. The 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent has failed to pay the Claimant's holiday entitlement and is ordered to pay the Claimant a sum **of £493.10**.
- 6. The claims of unfair dismissal and unlawful deduction of wages are withdrawn and dismissed.
- 7. The total compensation payable by the 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent to the Claimant **is £8,363.74**.
