I, the undersigned, certify that the birds comprising the flock of origin meet the following requirements:

- a) the birds comprising the flock(s) of origin have been inspected and found to be free from clinical signs of infectious disease;
- b) in so far as can be determined, there has been no evidence of the following diseases at the farms of origin during the past 6 months: **fowl pox, fowl cholera, ornithosis/psittacosis, Marek's disease, avian leukosis, infectious laryngotracheitis, infectious bronchitis, infectious avian encephalomyelitis or mycoplasmosis (chronic respiratory disease);**
- c) the originating parent flocks have not been treated or fed with any natural or synthetic hormonal substances, antibiotics or toxic substances carcinogenic or otherwise which exceed European Union maximum permitted levels;
- d) the flock(s) of origin are members of a Government supervised poultry health scheme and are considered free from **Salmonella pullorum** (pullorum disease) and **Salmonella gallinarum** (fowl typhoid);
- e) the farm(s) of origin is(are) under official supervision and are free from **Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza**.
