JUDGMENT

- 1. The claim for unpaid holiday pay succeeds. The claimant is entitled to 2.64 days unpaid holiday.
- 2. The claim for breach of contract, being failure to pay notice pay, succeeds.
- 3. The claimant's employment was ended by reason of redundancy and is entitled to statutory redundancy pay
- 4. The claimant is awarded
 - i. £316.80 (gross) being 2.6 days unpaid accrued annual leave; and
 - ii. £600 (gross) being 1 week's notice pay, the claimant mitigated his loss after one week; and
 - iii. £1, 713 statutory redundancy pay (calculated as 2×1.5× £571)
