RECORD OF HEARING

Neither party attended the hearing or was represented. The respondent has not filed a response to the claim and a rule 21 warning letter has previously been sent. The claimant attended a case management hearing by telephone on 12 May 2023. The parties were directed to file and serve witness evidence by 9 June 2023. Neither party complied. The parties were reminded of this direction by the Tribunal on 16 June 2023. No further correspondence or evidence has been received from either party.
