JUDGMENT

The Tribunal's judgment is as follows:

- 1. The claims of unfair dismissal and disability discrimination in case 3300090/2023 are dismissed following withdrawal by the claimant.
- 2. The claim of unfair dismissal in case 3312806/2022 was submitted out of time. The Claimant has not shown that it was not reasonably practicable to present the claim within the normal time limit, and it is struck out because the Tribunal does not have jurisdiction to consider it.
- 3. The claim of disability discrimination in case 3312806/2022 was submitted out of time. The Claimant has not shown that it would be just and equitable to extend time, and it is struck out because the Tribunal does not have jurisdiction to consider it.
