## JUDGMENT

1. Miss Bradley's complaint of breach of contract succeeds. Maria White Limited must pay Miss Bradley the sum of £805.92 in respect of outstanding notice pay due for the period 27 February to 20 March 2021.
2. This amount is the net sum due, and it must be paid to Miss Bradley in full.
3. The gross sum due was £1,044.00. Maria White Limited has already paid to HMRC the sum of £208.80 in respect of tax due on the outstanding notice pay, and the sum of £29.28 in respect of employee national insurance payments due on the outstanding notice pay.
