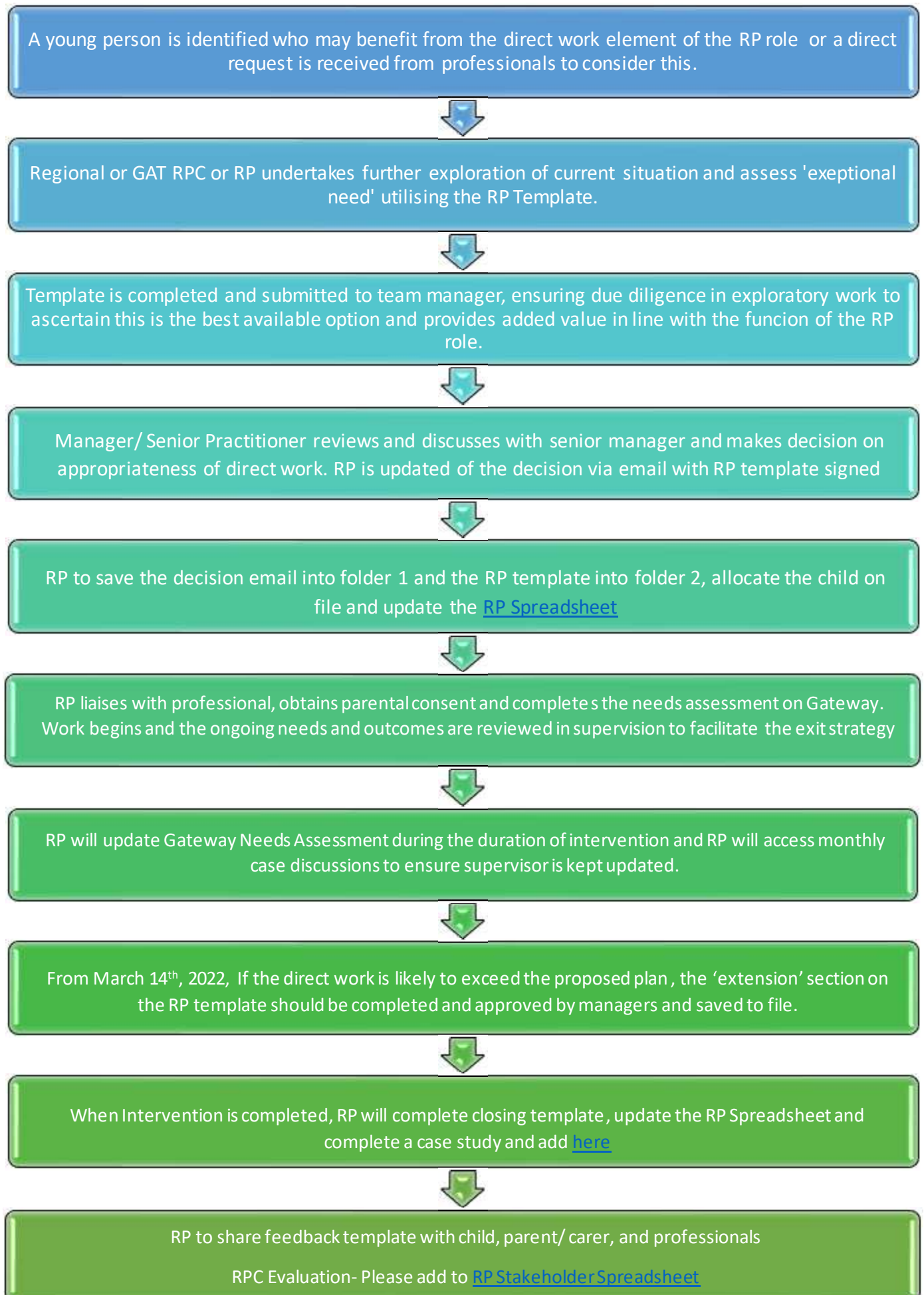


## RP Flowchart

<b>Brief Overview of child background</b> -can include past trauma, harm and Adverse Childhood Experiences			
<b>History and wider context of trafficking concerns</b> -Consider any previous trafficking, risk of re trafficking and trafficking within family or peer groups			
<b>Availability of suitable services, professionals, and agencies</b> -What agencies are already involved or available in area, exploration of suitable professionals who could support the child with long arm RPC support and advice, include agencies, roles and reasons why the support isn't applicable.			
<b>Key characteristics of Child's Individual Needs and Exceptional Circumstances</b>			
<b>Supporting Evidence</b> -Highlight discussions and views of partner agencies, and exploration that has taken place to meet current needs of child, includes dates of emails, meetings and discussions			
<b>Proposed Short Term Support Plan</b> -Consider the impact of a short term and time limited support and highlight the exit strategy to continued support if required. Identify the proposed length of support and review period, how will the support be utilised effectively in the least disruptive manner, what are the overall aims of the proposed short term RP support e.g bridging, services, exit support prior to transition to 18, stabilisation/outreach.			
<b>Provide Overview of discussions, decision and rational between RP's, managers, and Senior managers.</b>

<b>Extension to Proposed Intervention</b> It's important the RP seeks to complete the intervention of support during as initially discussed in line with the short-term element of the support. However, there will be times when there will need to be an adaption of the initial plan by way of extension, if the child's has outstanding needs that remain unmet from the perspective of child trafficking. To confirm an extension, the RP should liaise with the line manager and discuss rational and agree the new proposed plan.			
<b>RP Overview of the child's continued unmet need in relation to Trafficking</b>

## Post 18 Pathway Flowchart

A young person is identified who may benefit from support Post 18 support



Post 18 worker completes Post 18 assessment framework and Post 18 Decision making framework for any newly referred young person who is 17.5 yrs + or 1 x month before the 18th birthday.

Allocated ICTG to complete paperwork (supported by manager & post 18 worker) for a young person who is transitioning from ICTG support



Manager & Post 18 worker discuss information gathered. Manager makes decision on appropriateness of ongoing support. Decision and rationale is recorded and signed off on the Post 18 template



Post 18 Worker to save Post 18 template into folder 2, and update the Post 18 Spreadsheet.

Complete relevant sections on Gateway and Local Data Form



Work begins, with clear targets and plan and supervision with manager to ensure exit strategy is considered. Reviews completed on a monthly basis in supervision, plan is updated in line with outcomes achieved and next steps



Post 18 Worker completes work, collates feedback (professionals, young person) completes needs assesment on Gateway. Post 18 Worker to write a closing report and case study.
