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Phase 2a: Air Quality and Dust Monitoring Summary Report

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## **Monthly Summary**

- 1.1.1 This Summary Report is published in fulfilment of commitments detailed in the High Speed Rail (West Midlands to Crewe) Environmental Minimum Requirements, Annex 1: Code of Construction Practice, for the nominated undertaker to present the results of air quality monitoring undertaken in Stafford Borough Council (SBC), Newcastle-under-Lyme Borough Council (NBC) and Cheshire East Council (CEC) during March 2023.
- 1.1.2 Figure 1 in Appendix A indicates the current air quality monitoring locations.
- 1.1.3 This summary should be read in conjunction with the overview monitoring report monthly available from <a href="www.gov.uk/government/collections/monitoring-the-environmental-effects-of-hs2">www.gov.uk/government/collections/monitoring-the-environmental-effects-of-hs2</a>, which highlights the applicable standards and guidance, as well as monitoring methodology, to be followed by the nominated undertakers in undertaking the required air quality and dust monitoring.
- 1.1.4 There are no current worksites located within this area. Therefore, no dust monitoring has been carried out.
- 1.1.5 Diffusion tube monitoring of Nitrogen dioxide (NO<sub>2</sub>) was undertaken at ten (10) locations in March 2023, around highways within SBC, NBC and CEC as part of the management of air quality where significant effects may occur as a result of the scheme.
- 1.1.6 Diffusion tube monitoring results are as provided from the laboratory analysis, and therefore still require various analysis and adjustments to be undertaken. Final corrected results will be presented and described in the annual report. However, based on the results to date, no unexpected values were recorded during the monitoring period.
- 1.1.7 NO<sub>2</sub> monitoring locations and results are presented in Appendix B, Table 1 alongside the running average for 2023.
- 1.1.8 There were no (0) complaints received during this reporting period (April 2023).

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
