Royal Navy and Royal Marines Families Survey 2023

The Ministry of Defence is now in its first year of implementing the new Armed Forces Families Strategy (published Jan 2022 and guiding policy until 2032). Whilst this document signals our broad intent and sets out specific themes under which we will be concentrating our efforts, the action plans that are being developed from it will be shaped by a range of factors including our developing understanding of what life is really like for Service families.

The Families Continuous Attitude Survey (FamCAS) plays a significant part in this process. The metrics of FamCAS offer us an incomparably valuable data set stretching back 10 years before the publication of this ambitious strategy. The feedback that we receive through this and other sources will also help us assess whether we are achieving the goals we have set ourselves. Each completed survey offers a slightly more complete picture and the more survey responses that we receive, the clearer and more representative this picture becomes. The results of this survey will be available on the Government website.

We are clear that whilst the unique demands associated with service will remain, the Ministry of Defence is committed to reducing the family related frictions that arise from these and to ensure that family life and military life are as compatible as possible.

What is this survey about?

The Royal Navy and Royal Marines Families Survey (FAMCAS) provides RN and RM spouses/civil partners with an opportunity to share their views on what Service life is like. The survey asks questions about key areas including family life, childcare, deployment, education, employment, healthcare, and housing.

Why have I received this survey?

The RN/RM Families Survey is sent to a random sample of Service personnel each year, located both within the UK and overseas, inviting their families to participate.

How are the findings used?

The results from the survey are used to aid the assessment and development of Service personnel policies and initiatives, including the Armed Forces Covenant.

We are interested in capturing the views of both military and civilian partners. If you and your spouse/civil partner are both serving in the Armed Forces, this survey should be completed by the spouse/civil partner of the named recipient of the survey.

2022 FamCAS HEADLINE REPORT SUMMARY OF KEY FINDINGS

Response rates. 8,466 Regular Army Service Personnel (SP) were sent the Families Continuous Attitude Survey (FamCAS) to pass onto their spouses. The response rate was 22% (n=1,838) for 2022 which is 6% less than last year.

About you. The majority of respondents are female (94%), 78% have children, and 44% are below the age of 35. Spouses / partners of ORs tend to be younger than those of Officers with 20% of Officers' spouses and 51% of ORs' spouses under the age of 35. Seven percent of spousal respondents are 'dual serving' with the majority (83%) having 'never served in the Armed Forces'. Most spouses are located in England (54%) and, from those who responded from England, over two thirds were based in the South (66%).

Accommodation. Fifty-one percent of spouses report they own their own home which is a 4% point decrease since 2021 but consistent with previous years. This decrease is attributable to the responses of ORs' spouses with a significant decrease from 47% in 2021 to 42% this year in those reporting they own their own home, but returning to levels seen prior to 2021. This is significantly higher in families of Officers (78%) compared with ORs (42%). Fewer Army families report owning their own the compared to the other Services (RN/RM=76%, RAF=68%).

Of those who reported owning their house, they have continued to cite the 'stability of themselves and their family' (72%) as the main reason for buying a house. This is followed by 'financial investment' (29%) and 'due to the poor standard of SFA' (21%).

Of the top three reasons selected by respondents for not owning a house are: 54% 'cannot afford to buy a suitable home at the moment' (similar to last year but a reduction of 9% from 2018), 39% feel 'living in Service accommodation suited their family's needs at the present time' (19% point decrease in Officers' spouses citing this reason this year (2021=54%, 2022=35%) and 32% want to 'move with their spouse when they are posted' (remained stable since 2019).

Of respondents who 'live in Service Family Accommodation (SFA) during the working week' (68%), nearly two thirds (62%) report being satisfied with the 'value for money' of SFA (compared with 65% in 2021) and 61% report being satisfied with the 'security of your SFA'. Fifty-three percent reported they are satisfied with the overall standard, which is similar to last year, however this is a significant decrease of 8% points since 2019 (61%). The highest levels of reported dissatisfaction continue to be around repairs and maintenance, with 52% reporting being dissatisfied in the 'response to maintenance/repair requests', a significant 10% point increase compared with 2019, and 50% report being dissatisfied with the 'quality of maintenance/repair work', a significant increase of 6% points since 2020.

Spousal employment. Since 2018 there has been an upward trend in the spouses who reported they were employed (2018=72%, 2022=79%) with a rise of 4% since last year to 79%. This remains below the other Services (RN/RM=83%, RAF=86%). More Officers' (82%) than ORs' spouses (77%) report being employed. Of those seeking work (43%), just under two-thirds of spouses (64%) report experiencing difficulties finding suitable employment (a

4% point decrease since 2021 and significant 10% point decrease from 2015). The two main reasons cited for this continue to be related to care responsibilities: 'extended family living too far away to assist with childcare' (45%) and 'partner not being able to assist with care responsibilities' (43%).

Service Life: In a similar picture to last year the top three aspects of Service life which respondents feel most positive about are 'pride in my spouse being in the Army' (80%), the 'Armed Forces pension' (63%), and thirdly (up from fourth most positive last year), their 'job security' (62%). The three aspects of Service life which respondents feel most negative about are 'effect on career' (56%), up 5% points since last year; 'my spouse/civil partner's worklife balance' (47%), up 8% points since 2021 and 'amount of separation from spouse/civil partner' (46%), up 4% points since last year; with 9%, 24% and 7% feeling positive about these points respectively. These have reverted to pre-COVID levels.

Childcare. Seventy-eight percent of respondents have children under the age of 18 (3% less than 2021), 22% have one child, 37% have two children and 19% have three or more. Thirty-three percent report having children are under the age of five. Seventy four percent of respondents report needing childcare. Thirty percent require early years (0-4) childcare and 43% require school-age childcare. There is a significant 6% point increase in those needing school-age childcare since 2021 but not quite returning to levels seen in 2018-2020 (44-47%). Of those who needed (0-4) childcare, 88% were able to access. Of those who have children, 29% did not need informal childcare and 45% were unable to access informal childcare.

Children's education. Of those who have children of school age, 28% (n=283) report difficulties with their children's schooling while 72% do not. While this is a 2% point decrease from last year, the proportion of families reporting difficulties has increased by 9% points since 2019. Those reporting they were allocated their first choice of school has decreased by 10% points and by 18% points compared with 2020. The three main reported difficulties experienced were 'not getting a place at the school of choice' (9%) (n=90), 'obtaining support for special education needs' (7%) (n=70) which is similar to last year. Furthermore, 'distance from school' was highlighted as a difficulty by 6% (n=60) of respondents.

Armed Forces Covenant (AFC). In a similar picture to last year, just under two thirds of respondents (63%) have 'heard of the AFC' with 37% who have not. Of those who have, 16% 'know nothing about it'. On covenant issues, when compared to the general public, Army spouses report feeling more disadvantaged than advantaged with regards to Family life (39%:11%), Childcare (36%:5%), Education (23%:14%), Healthcare (27%:14%), and Access to commercial products and services (21%:10%). Housing was the only area where spouses felt more advantaged (31%) than disadvantaged (18%), however, significantly fewer feel they are advantaged with housing than in previous years (2019=37%, 2020=39%). This year there is a significant increase in Army spouses reporting they feel disadvantaged when compared to the general public on 'healthcare' (continuing an upward increase of 6% from 2021 to 27%). The percentage of respondents who feel disadvantaged about education compared with public has remained stable (23%).

Wellbeing. Similar to previous years, less Army spouses report very low (24%) or low (20%) levels of anxiety compared with the general public[1] (very low=33%, low=25%) the day before they completed the survey. Twenty-four percent report medium levels of anxiety, and just under a third (32%) experienced high levels of anxiety compared with 23% of the general public. Fifty-seven percent of Army spouses reported feeling happy (high/very high) yesterday (Officers=66%, ORs=54%), compared to 72% of the general public.
