## JUDGMENT

**The judgment of the tribunal, and with the consent of the respondent, is that:**

1. The claimant's claim for damages for breach of contract over notice or failure to pay in lieu of notice is well-founded. The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant the sum of £3,287.67 (gross).

2. The claimant's claim for holidays accrued but not taken or paid is well-founded. The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant compensation in the sum of £243.59 (gross).
