## JUDGMENT

1. The Claimant's claims for wrongful dismissal, notice pay and unlawful deductions from wages are not well founded and are dismissed.
2. The Claimant's claim for holiday pay is well founded and the respondent is ordered to pay the gross sum of £63.46 to the Claimant.
3. The Respondent's contract claim against the Claimant is allowed and the Claimant is ordered to pay the Respondent the sum of £355.16.
4. The net amount due from the Claimant to the Respondent (taking account of paragraphs 2 and 3 above) is £291.70.
