Opinion

We have audited the financial statements of the Artists' Union England (the 'Union') for the year ended 31 December 2022 which comprise the income and expenditure account, the balance sheet and notes to the financial statements, including a summary of significant accounting policies. - Performing audit work over the risk of management bias and override of controls, including testing of
 journal entries and other adjustments for appropriateness, evaluating the business rationale of significant
 transactions outside the normal course of business and reviewing accounting estimates for indicators of
 potential bias.


