JUDGMENT

The complaint of **discrimination on the grounds of religion or belief** is struck out.

REASONS

1. By a letter dated 5 April 2023 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to make representations or to request a hearing, as to why the complaint of discrimination on the grounds of religion or belief should not be struck out because -
 - The claim in respect of discrimination on the grounds of religion or belief is not established by a tick in the box, in the absence of particulars
 - That claim has no reasonable prospect of success, the claimant having provided no grounds of her claim
 - The Claimant has not complied with the Order of the Tribunal dated 6 April 2022 in respect of either the claim in respect of discrimination on the grounds of religion and belief or the claim for other payments
 - The claims have not been actively pursued
2. The claimant has failed to make representations in writing, or has failed to make any sufficient representations, why this should not be done or to request a hearing. The complaint of discrimination on the grounds of religion or belief is therefore struck out.
3. The claimant's remaining claim of unfair dismissal remains listed for hearing on 13-17 November 2023
