CORRECTED JUDGMENT

- 1. The name of the respondent is amended to 'The Furzedown Group Limited a.k.a The Furzedown Group'.
- 2. The respondent made unauthorised deductions from wages by failing to pay the claimant the full amount of wages due for the period 1 February 2022 until 7 March 2022 and is ordered to pay to the claimant £4,687.50 gross being the sum withheld.
- 3. The respondent made an unauthorised deduction from wages by failing to pay the claimant in lieu of accrued but untaken annual leave on termination of employment and is ordered to pay to the claimant £2,546.00 gross being the sum due.
- 4. The respondent was in breach of contract by dismissing the claimant without notice and the respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant damages of £3,125 for that breach.
