JUDGMENT

It is the judgment of the Tribunal that:

- 1. Each of the Claimants' complaints under s.189(1) of the Trade Union and Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992 is well-founded.
- 2. The protected period for each Claimant was 10 December 2020 to 9 March 2021.
- 3. The Claimants are entitled to the following protective awards, based on their net pay in the protected period:
