# JUDGMENT

The unanimous decision of the Tribunal is as follows:

- 1. The claimant was unfairly dismissed.
- A reduction in the compensatory award for unfair dismissal will be made under the principles in Polkey v A E Dayton Services Limited 1988 ICR 142. The Tribunal finds that if a fair procedure had been followed the claimant would have been dismissed in any event on 11 June 2020.
- 3. The complaints of direct discrimination on the grounds of race and religion fail and are dismissed.
- 4. The claim of harassment on the grounds of religion fails and is dismissed.
- 5. The respondent must pay the claimant the sum of £1502.32, comprising financial losses of £1211.55 and interest on those losses of £290.77.
