JUDGMENT

Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 - Rule 21

- 1. The claim was issued in the Bristol Employment Tribunals on 16 February 2023.
- 2. The Respondent has failed to present a valid response on time.
- 3. The Employment Judge has decided that a determination can properly be made of the claim, or part of it, in accordance with rule 21 of the Rules of Procedure.

Miss V Jacomb:

- 4. The Respondent has made unauthorised deductions from the Claimant's wages and must pay the Claimant, £5,572.60 gross.
- 5. The Claimant was dismissed in breach of contract in respect of notice and the Respondent must pay damages to the Claimant of £6,687.08.
- 6. The Respondent has failed to pay the Claimant's holiday entitlement and must pay the Claimant £459.74.
- 7. The Respondent must pay the Claimant £12,719.42 in total.

Miss A Paget:

- 8. The Claimant was dismissed in breach of contract in respect of notice and the Respondent must pay damages to the Claimant of £2,439.84.
- 9. The Claimant was dismissed by reason of redundancy and is entitled to a redundancy payment of £1,677.39.
- 10. The Respondent must pay the Claimant £4,117.23 in total.
- 11. The hearing listed on 8 September 2023 at 10:00am has now been vacated
