# JUDGMENT

1. The claimant's complaints under section 189 of the Trade Union and Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992 ("the 1992 Act") of a failure by the first respondent to comply with the requirements of sections 188 and 188A of the 1992 Act are well-founded.
2. The Tribunal orders the respondent by way of a protective award under section 189(3) of the 1992 Act to pay to the claimant a payment equivalent to her remuneration for the period of 90 days beginning on 18 November 2022.
3. The respondent has failed to pay the claimant's holiday entitlement and must pay the claimant £2660.64.
