Hope you're well.

As you are aware the Minister attended a Westminster Hall Debate today on South East Water's performance during the freeze thaw incidents last year.

Greg Clark MP and Helen Grant MP gave accounts from their constituents on the impact of having no water, as the interruptions caused significant stress and inconvenience to households, businesses and medical facilities.

The Minister would like to set up a meeting to discuss these incidents, South East Water's wider performance, your actions to increase your resilience and improve your incident planning to ensure the needs of the local population are better met.

I am aware that you are currently assessing compensation levels and I wanted to relay a key message from today's debate. The Minister was asked that compensation levels should go beyond statutory requirements and that South East Water should make a contribution to the wider community as well affected households. Helen Grant asked about compensation to businesses and gave an example of how a pub in her constituency lost their entire Christmas income.

Greg Clark was also concerned about how interruptions were recorded as some households had water available at times when they would be asleep and therefore would not have needed water at that time. He asked that compensation should reflect the entirety of the disruption period. There will be a lot of ministerial interest in the level of compensation provided and the Minister would welcome more information on your compensation package prior to any public messaging.
