## JUDGMENT

1. The Respondent has made an unauthorised deduction from the Claimant's wages by failing to pay the Claimant the full amount of wages due on 28 February 2022 and is ordered to pay to the Claimant the gross sum of £2,149.53 in respect of the amount unlawfully deducted. The Respondent is entitled to make any deductions which are due for tax and national insurance purposes.

2. The Respondent has made an unauthorised deduction from wages by failing to pay the Claimant in lieu of accrued but untaken annual leave of 5 days on termination of employment and is ordered to pay to the Claimant the gross sum of  $\pounds496.02$ , in respect of the amount unlawfully deducted. The Respondent is entitled to make any deductions which are due for tax and national insurance purposes.
